Reception accorded to RDC Cadet

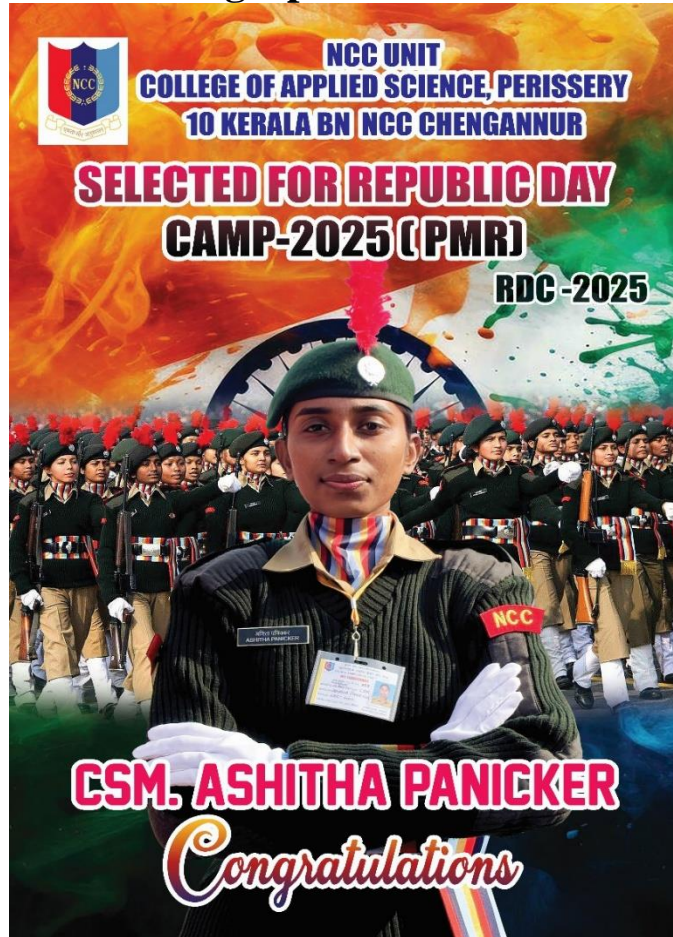

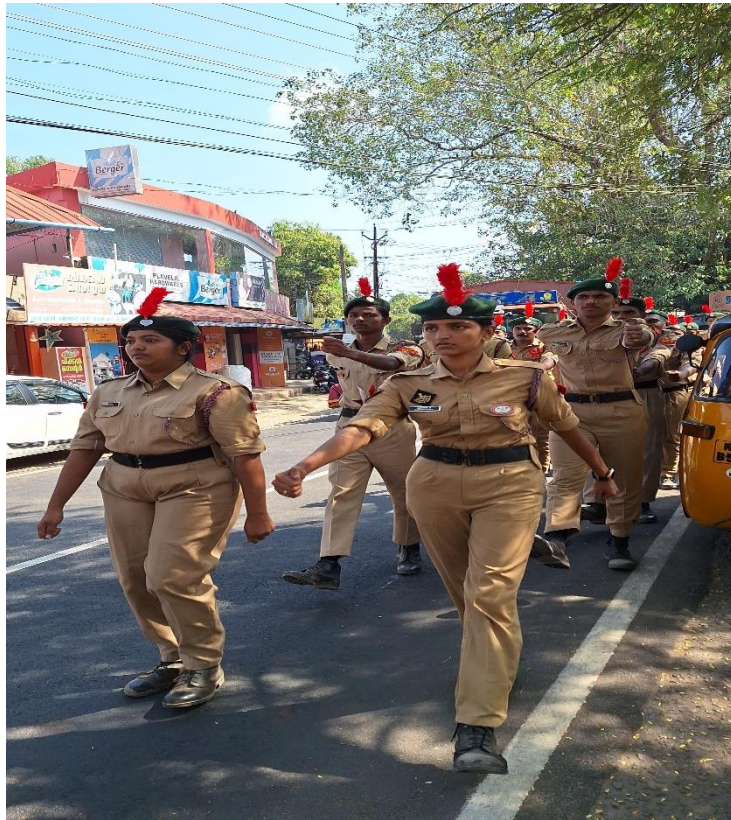

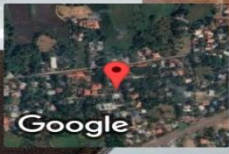
