The quiz competition was highly engaging and informative, and it fostered a sense of patriotism among students. After an exciting series of rounds, the winning team was declared, with the following winners:

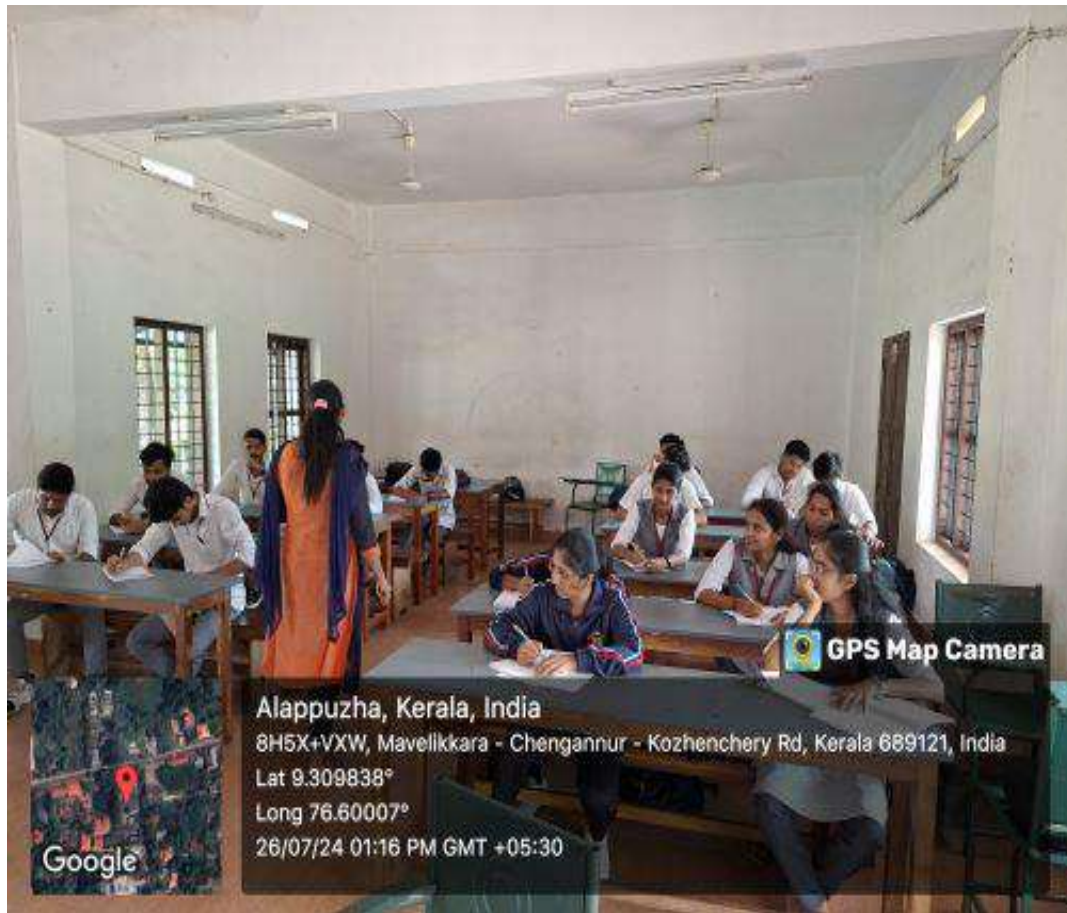

- Patriotism and responsibility: Encouraging students to contribute to the country's growth, to engage in national service, and to preserve the dignity of the nation.

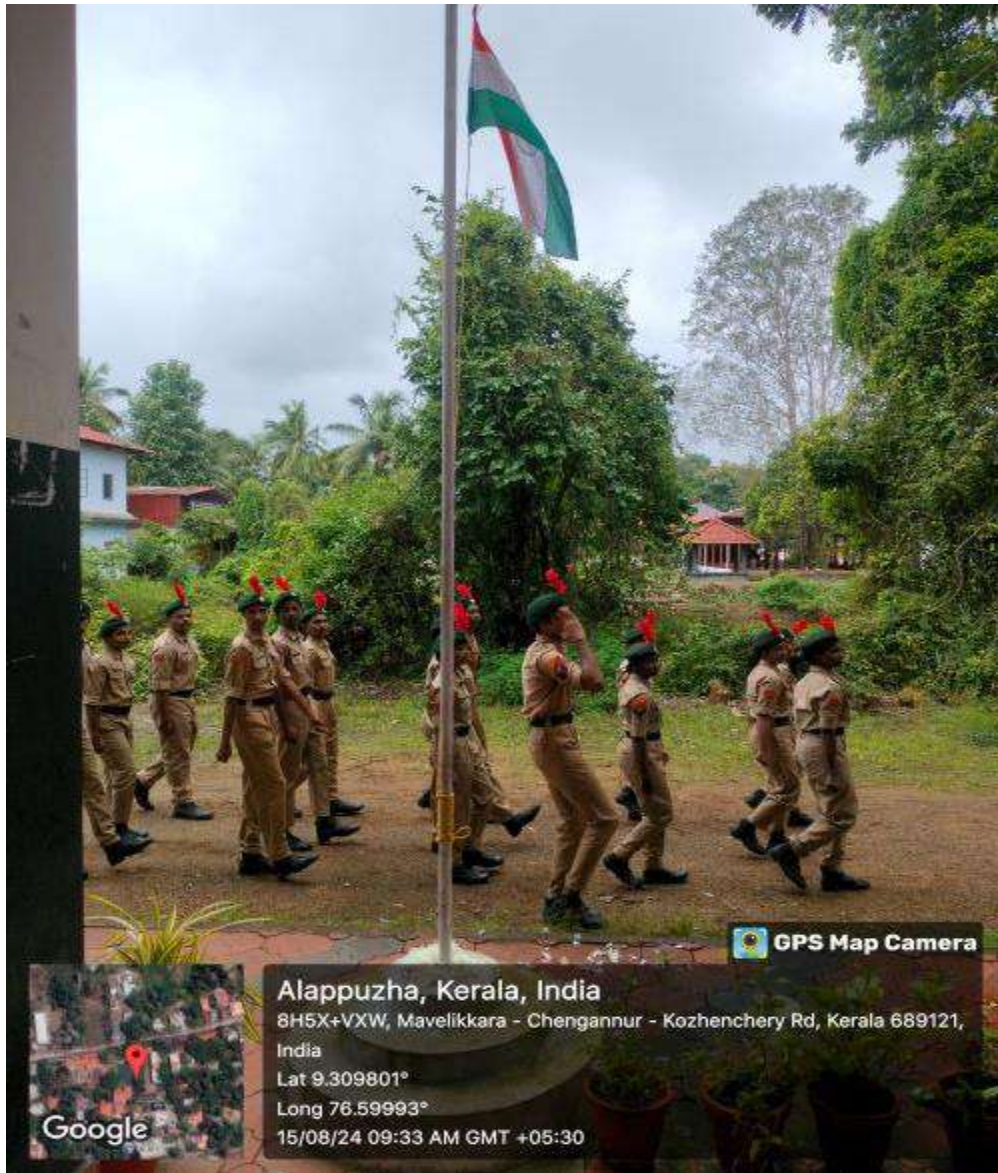

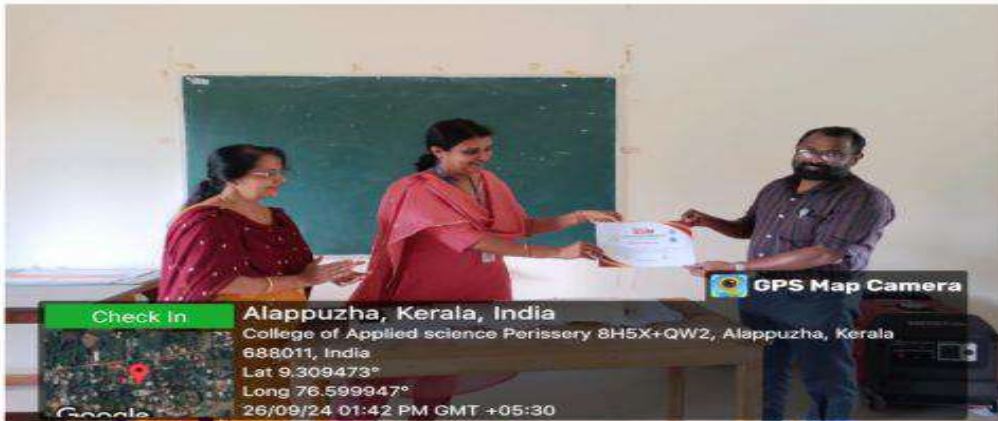

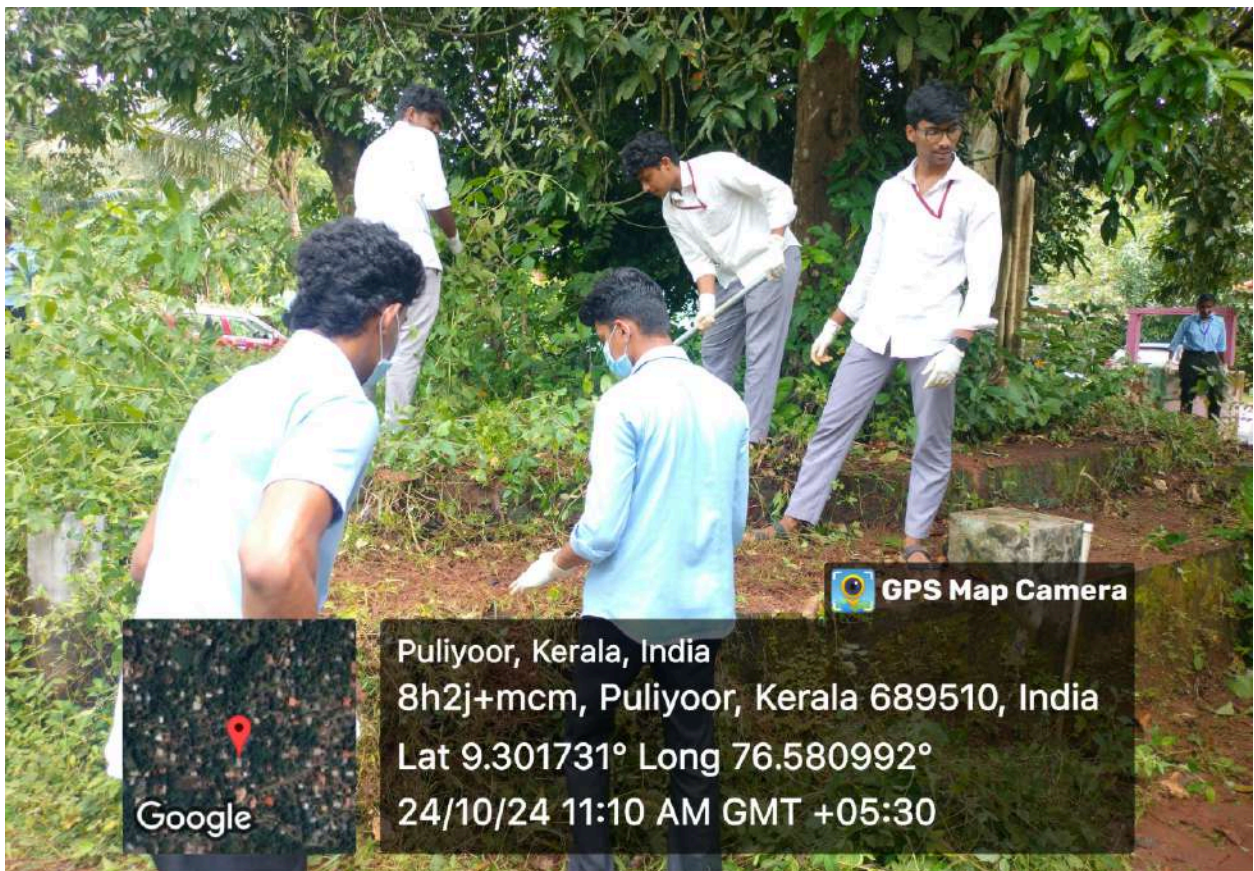
4. REPORT

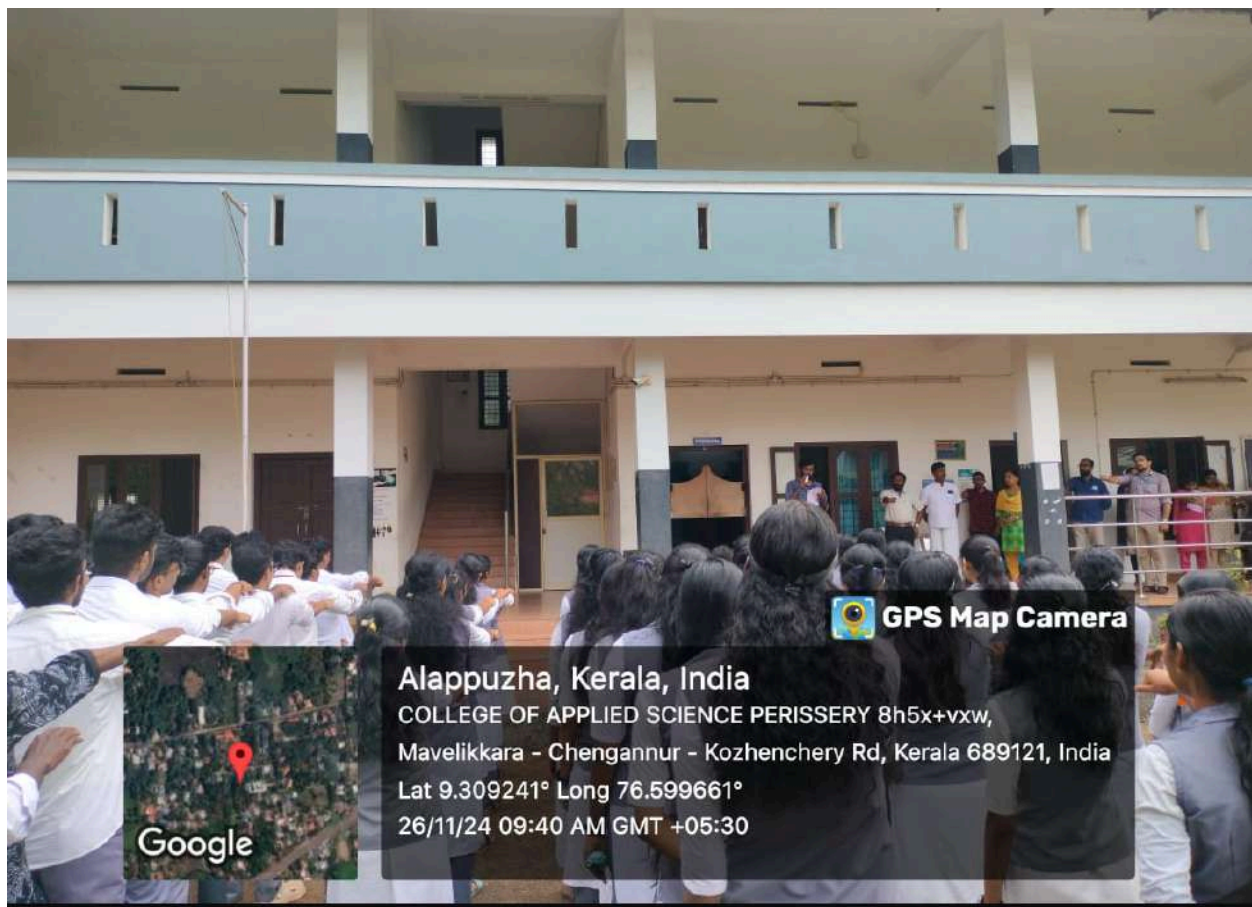
8. REPORT
